## Covid Procedures Review for re-opening April 2022

At the time of writing (mid-February 2022) there are no compulsory legislative restrictions which would affect us playing bridge face-to-face. However, some of the remaining Guidance Notes may still be relevant.

Most guidance is directed at individuals:

- Wear a face covering in crowded and enclosed spaces
- Take a lateral flow test before being in close contact with other people
- Wash hands regularly

For the organisers of indoor meetings there is a recommendation to keep areas well-ventilated.

BDBC previous Covid Protocols were based on earlier regulations and they can now be relaxed. However, the committee has agreed that we will continue to retain some of our past procedures for the safety of our members:

- 1. We ask members to have had three vaccinations before attending the club (as before, no checks on this)
- 2. Please do not attend if you are showing classical Covid symptoms
- 3. Feel free to wear a face mask if you want to
- 4. We will continue to spread the tables wider than we did pre-pandemic, but remove the maximum limit of eight tables
- 5. We will continue to keep some windows open for ventilation if weather conditions are appropriate and comfort is not compromised
- 6. We will continue to provide sanitiser at each table
